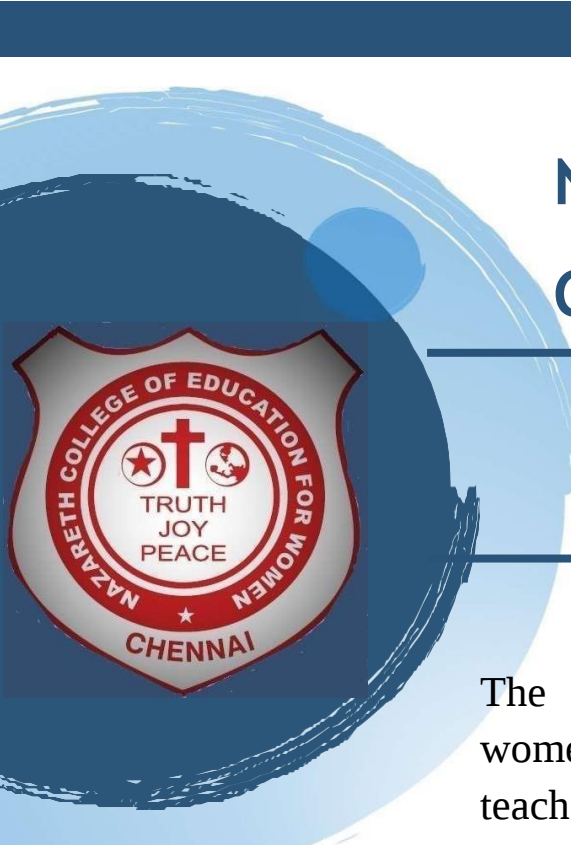

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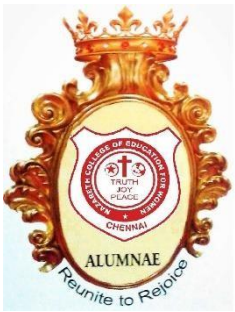

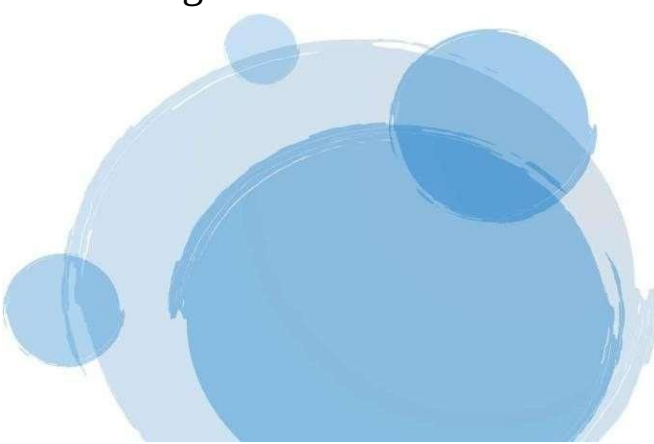
The student teachers are trained to focus on higher order thinking skills and equipped with life skills to face Global challenges.
