CONSOLIDATED ACTION TAKEN REPORT FOR THE ACADEMIC YEAR: 2021-22

- Webinars on various topics were organized Effective online teaching learning strategies and ethics, Intellectual property rights, Reflective teachers, Bloom's Taxonomy, Recent methods and techniques in teaching, and Eco-restoration were conducted.
- Staff members used team teaching techniques to orient the students on the various skills of microteaching and encouraged them to practice it.
- Alumnae was invited to orient the students on swayam course enrollment and online submission of assignments and graded quizzes.
- Distribution of materials to balwadi (fan, LED bulbs), HIV patients (protein food, dates, green gram, boiled eggs, health mix), rural people(tarpaulin sheets, rice bags, food packets, slippers, fruits and biscuits, provisions), an orphanage (mats), cancer patients(cancer medicines, colostomy bags).
