Started with the approval of National Council of Teacher Education and with the No Objection Certificate from the Govt. of Tamilnadu, the College is further recognized by the affiliation granted by the University of Madras and now it is affiliated to Tamilnadu Teachers Education University.

The academic year 2006-07 was started with a strength of 95 students, a team of qualified staff and a Principal. The college excelled in curricular and co-curricular activities and thus the year produced very good results at the University Examination. The very first batch brought 100% pass with all first classes.

In the year 2007-08 our Biological Science student Ms.R.Jebapriya got the First Rank while Ms.Vasantha Priya of Physical Science, got the Ninth rank respectively in the University B.Ed., Examination.

In the year 2008-09 all the students passed out with First Class and distinction.

GENERAL DISCIPLINE

EXTRACT FROM THE MADRAS EDUCATION RULES CHAPTER VII DISCIPLINE REGULATIONS

1. Students of School and Colleges should abstain from active participation in party or communal politics.
2. Headmasters, Principals or other constituted school, college or hostel authorities may frame and issue from time to time disciplinary rules of a permanent or temporary character regulating the conduct outside the school, college or hostel precincts of students on the rolls, so far as such rules seem necessary to maintain the credit, usefulness and reputation of the school or college and Hostel.

Note:

In the case of colleges such disciplinary regulations as may be issued by the respective universities to which they are affiliated to and are not inconsistent with the regulations in the chapter will also apply.

3. Headmasters, Principals and other constituted school, college or hostel authorities shall have full power to inflict the following punishment in the interest of the institution concerned – fine, loss of attendance, loss of term certificate, suspension and expulsion

GENERAL RULES AND REGULATIONS

PAYMENT OF FEES:

1. Fees to be paid as per the instructions given at the time of admission
2. Failing to pay the fees on time will result in the deletion of names of the defaulters and inclusion of names from the waiting list.

ATTENDANCE

3. Attendance is very important. Lack of attendance will disqualify a student from appearing for the University Examination.
4. In case of necessity, leave Letter should be submitted to the Principal with Parent /Guardian signature and through the respective head of the department.
5. A Medical Certificate should be submitted in case of long leave exceeding 4 days.

CODE OF CONDUCT

6. Every student will abide by the rules and regulations of the college. Three warnings of misbehavior will result in the students admission being cancelled.
7. Uniform should be worn on every first day of the week when General Assembly will be held, Hair should be neatly put up on those days.

8. Coming late to the college, not wearing uniform, not having a neatly tied up hair will incur a fine of Rs.25/-.
9. Three late coming will result in 1 day loss of attendance.
10. No meeting of any kind will be conducted by students in the college premises without a written permission
11. No. subscription of any kind shall be collected by students without a written request to the Principal.
12. Any grievance of the students should be given to the Principal in writing.
13. Any misbehavior outside the college campus is at the students own risk and the college will not be held responsible.
14. The use of Cell phone is banned within the campus., College phone can be used after getting permission.
15. Issuing of Transfer and Conduct certificate depend on producing 'No dues Certificate' from all the departments concerned.
16. Students are advised to see the Notice Board every day for important circulars.
17. The student trainees are expected to observe discipline and decorum befitting that of future teachers, both inside and outside college.

THE LIBRARY

RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. The library is equipped with more than 4457 quality books both general and subject. Every student is issued with 3 tickets to borrow 3 books.
2. Borrowing and returning of books should be done only during the timings notified on the notice board of the library.
3. Failure to return books in time will entail a fine of Rs.10/- per book per day.
4. Books on demand will be issued in the order of the date of requisition letters.
5. Reference books and periodicals will not be issued.
6. Strict silence should be maintained in the library.
7. No dues certificate from the library will be issued only after surrendering all the 3 tickets.
